Reports by officers

President Jim Fry:

Rene has resigned as Secretary and will no longer be able to perform these duties. We will be looking for a volunteer to complete her term. Until a new Secretary is found match results should be sent to Bill Allman, and Jim Fry.

By-law vote for raising club dues will be held at the next club meeting.

Vice President Victor Keeton:

A new paragraph for filling out the insurance waiver form will be added to the Operations Guidelines Report number 3.

Treasurer Jim Wishart:

Insurance waivers are ready to go. Will be mandatory each year with club dues, except this year, need signed prior to club dues. Insurance forms & lock boxes will be in the 200 yard range, and on the east side of the cowboy town range.

One of the CD's is coming due next month, investigating renewal options.
