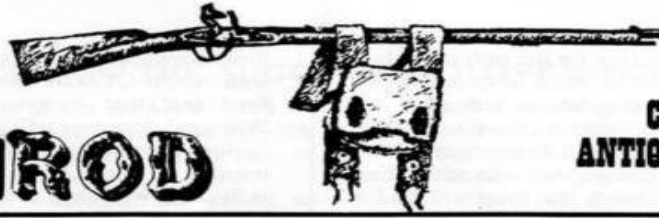

CTAGA Board Minutes - July 8, 2021

Board Members Present: Jim Fry, Ken Sackett, Lance Heath, Ken Henderson, Bill Allman,

Board Members Absent: Joe Base, Tim Pinkerton

Guests Present: Bill Mackes, Don Maxey, Ron Dyke

Jim Fry, President - opened the meeting. Thanked everyone for serving on the board this year. Thanked the previous board for their work during a difficult year. Suggested that all board members read Report #3 and the By-laws.

Jim asked for a motion to accept the previous boards actions and business. Bob Bartlett presented the motion. Motion to close previous year's business passed.

Jim asked questions on the new green card requirements. This new process is in effect as of July 1st, 2021.

Lance is updating the reports and updates will be handed to the board members and updated online.

Jim mentioned that budget proposals are due next month at the board meeting. We will discuss them and present them to the members in the August monthly meeting. The new budget will be from Sept. 1 through the following August.

Discussion was had on new Green Card candidates and finding sponsors for interested potential candidates. Bill Mackes discussed being a new candidate coordinator.

Bob has a proposal from Lamar on the billboard advertising same as previous years with the stated changes. The board approved the changes with Lamar on the billboard advertising changes. The board also approved Bob to make changes with KWCH on changing 15 second spots to 5 second spots during prime-time.

Ken Sackett, Vice-President - Ken will be absent from the August meetings for a family vacation.

Ken reported on behalf of Joe Base, Gun Show Chairman - working on a 3-year contract with Hartmann Arena. Got prices on a proposal on the next contract. Will ask and see if there is an incentive for a 5-year contract.

Bill Allman, Range Officer - Mowing has been fun with all the rain. Ken Sackett, Bill Randall, and Bill Allman have been working on Stage 1 in Cowboy Town. Annual fire inspection was this week. We passed with no violations! Fire extinguishers have been inspected as well. Mac will be inspecting the termite traps. Match directors will stay the same. Annual year-end match results are coming in. On August 1st, the gate codes will change. Guest waivers are being filled out. There is a need for directors for the Fall Rendezvous and Turkey Shoot. There was discussion on selling some of our Walnut trees.

Ken Henderson, Program Chairman - Jim Fry will contact the GPNC on if there are drinks and snacks allowed. Wes Lumry will be doing a presentation this month and Kevin Canada will be doing a presentation in August. Vaccinated members will not need to wear a mask.
