CTAGA Board Minutes - January 12, 2022

Board Members Present: Jim Fry, Ken Sackett, Ken Henderson, Bill Allman, Tim Pinkerton, Bob Bartlett, and Joe Base. Absent: Lance Heath

Jim Fry, President, opened the meeting. Discussion was held on the final draft of the Gun Show Door Guard Guides, no changes were made. Joe Base will provide a copy of these and discuss them with the Sheriff Officer Supervisor. Looking ahead to the next election of officers, Bill Allman is currently serving his third year as Range Officer and will not be eligible to run again this time. All other officers are eligible.

Bob Bartlett, Publicity Chairman – Joe Base's father has offered CTAGA the use of a road sign he owns located South of Goessel KS on highway K-15 for the purpose of advertising our Gun Shows. CTAGA Board has approved the payment for producing the two-sided metal sign insert and it will be available for the upcoming Spring Gun Show and beyond. (Thank you to Joe and his father for this generous offer) Television ads with KWCH (channel 12) will start on March 19 and run through March 26, same format and cost as last year.

Joe Base, Gun Show Chairman – Gun Show vendor correspondence has begun. Joe is working to get current information about the CTAGA show on the Kansas Gun Show web sites. New Gun Show business cards are needed and are in work, with future show dates listed.

Ken Sackett, Vice President - Checked on the Gun Show trailer stored at Hartman Arena, and it has two low tires. Ken will get the necessary tools and air those back up.

Bill Allman, Range Officer - The main gate (200-yard range) was damaged slightly by a vehicle and in need of repair. Monte Morris and he worked to repair the damaged gate. It is now back in working order and nearly like new. (Thanks to Monte Morris and Bill Allman) The shooting awards are in work and will be ready for the awards banquet, after a last-minute change in supplier was needed. The refrigerator in the 200-yard range house is acting up a bit and may be going out, so if anyone knows of a good used refrigerator, please let Bill know. There is a Range Work Party scheduled for Saturday, February 26.

Ken Henderson, Program Chairman – Awards banquet last minute details are being worked and the payment check to the Marriott will be deliver tomorrow. We will have 47 attendees at 6 tables.

Tim Pinkerton, Treasurer – The CTAGA list of property filed with the State of Kansas State was reviewed, no changes were made. Tim will be checking on the insurance for the upcoming March Gun Show with M&M, our club insurance provider.

Other Business: The need for a By-Laws change was discussed; addressing the lack of a quorum at our monthly meetings. Some Green Card members who have successfully completed their one-year requirement and are due to be voted at the completion of that time have been delayed due to a lack of a quorum. Also, the annual election of officers in June is in question without a quorum. A By-Law revision will be drafted with plans to review these changes at the March Board meeting.




