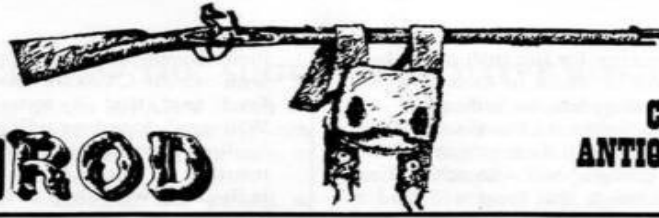

CTAGA Board Minutes - July 9, 2020

The board met while practicing social distancing (Covid-19).

Board Members Present: Bill Mackes, Mike Geiman, Lance Heath, Tim Pinkerton, Ron Dyke, Bill Allman, Don Maxey, and Bob Henderson.

Guests: Jim Fry, LeRoy Burgess, and Gerald McKinney.

Bill Mackes shared some interest information about himself. Thanked Jim for his guidance and direction.

Gerald McKinney introduced a Green Card applicant, Bill Randall. Had a good conversation with Bill and the Board approved his application.

LeRoy Burgess, club historian, shared with the board concerns on consistency, redundancy, and upkeep of our records, website, and documents.

Budget is due for next meeting.

Lance Heath – Expressed his concern about updating club membership records. Outdated information and missing information are key issues. Shared ideas on confirming information with club members on current information after renewals are done. Also shared that he is in the process of making a new website, but needs to obtain the current domain names; which are CTAGA property. Lance had questions for Bill Allman, Bill Mackes, Jim Fry and LeRoy Burgess on organization outlines for the new website.

Tim Pinkerton – Mentioned the fee associated with mailing the Ramrod. Proposed charging the members \$30 per year for Ramrod mailings, excluding life members. The board chose to proceed with this as a By-Laws change for next fiscal year. Tim proposed placing money from CD currently in savings into a money market account to earn more interest, both at Meritrust. The board approved this action. Researching moving an account from Bank of America to another bank. Will bring back a proposal next month.

Bill Allman – range maintenance is up to date. Fire extinguishers are inspected and up to code. Match directors are updated for the new year. Rock in Cowboy Town has been completed. Waivers have been checked and list is updated.

Mike Geiman – Will send a condolence card to Jim Dvorak.

Bob Henderson – Thanks to Ken Sackett and LeRoy Burgess for their help starting up. Thanks to Jerry Shoemaker as well. Extended invites to the board for communication and asked for help from the board. It is welcomed and appreciated. Visited Hartman Arena yesterday with Ken Sackett, and they would really like to see our Gun Show go through. They are having other events as well. Asked about concealed carry – OK, open carry only if you are a law-enforcement officer. LeRoy shared his guidelines and notes from previous gun shows. Bob also proposed having directions and procedures for all the volunteers for their job responsibilities. Door guards, gun check-in, etc.

Don Maxey – Cutoff date for outdoor advertising is August 3rd. Radio and TV are lined up, ready for September. Channel 12 has a promo package which includes some 5 second promos in addition to the 15 second ads for the original price. They also have online ad banners relating to their KWCH websites for 14 days before the Gun Show. The board voted to approve the online ad banners. Board moves on with Gun Show unless some agency stops us.

Ron Dyke – Check with Wes Lumry on July program. Will be scheduling the club safety meeting for August.

Club Meeting 6/16/2020 Minutes:

Due to the Great Plains Nature Center being closed to groups, we had our June club meeting at Cowboy Town to practice social distancing.

47 members present, 2 guests

President - Bill Mackes opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.

Brian Hainstock was absent for military service and is asking for reinstatement into the club. The club voted to approve his reinstatement.

Fall Rendezvous will be moved to Nov 6-8. An alternate date was requested by Mike Postelthwait.

Wes Lumry shared that Terry Noss broke his kneecap and has had surgery. He will be unavailable to cook the stew for the Rondi. Looking for someone to head-up. There are people able to help.

VP - Mike Geiman sent condolence cards to Turk's family and Jim Dvorak's wife, Linda. Asked about memorial donations.

Range Officer - Bill Allman - Rock wall repair completed. Fire extinguishers are inspected. Trap machine in acting up and should not be used until further notice. The breakers will be turned off, so please do not use. Everyone that uses the trap machine should clean up when complete. It has been quite messy the past few times that Bill has checked. Treasurer - Tim Pinkerton - absent due to illness. Jim Wishart reminded everyone that July 31st is the last day to pay dues with a late fee. In August, dues may be paid with a \$10 late fee.

Secretary - Lance Heath thanks everyone for updating information. If anyone has any updates, let him know. Green card members should contact Lance to give him their contact information. Anyone not receiving the Ramrod should let Lance know. The new website is mostly created but we need to get the domain released so we may use it for the new website.

Gun Show Chair - Bob Henderson has had conversations with Hartman and the majority of our vendors. All of the vendors have had good luck in their shows so far and are very interested in our show. Backing out could cause us to lose vendors and a loss in our reputation. Hartman has stated that they will follow whatever recommendations that Sedgwick County recommends.

Phillip Journey shared that he has a 3-year term with the NRA. National meeting is at Springfield on . Register to vote. Election information. Went to several parades. Asked for everyone's support.

Wes Lumry asked about our insurance coverage. Jim Wishart explained that the coverages hasn't really changed, but the rates do go up each year. About \$9,000 for the club for this year. 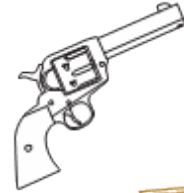
